## FALLS PREVENTION COMPLIANCE REPORT

The table below gives guidance on assigning scores for each criterion.

Score	Rationale
<b>0%</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ No compliance anywhere in the organisation with any of the requirements set by the criterion</li> </ul>
<b>1%-29%</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ A low degree of organisation-wide compliance with the requirements set by the criterion</li> <li>◆ Demonstrable evidence that a start has been made towards compliance in some or all parts of the organisation</li> <li>◆ Low percentage of compliance by professional people as part of the self-assessment process</li> </ul>
<b>30%-69%</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ A moderate degree of organisation-wide compliance with the requirements set by the criterion</li> <li>◆ Demonstrable evidence that work is ongoing across most parts of the organisation to achieve compliance, though some areas of the organisation may be in the early stages of implementation</li> <li>◆ Medium percentage of compliance by professional people as part of the self-assessment process</li> </ul>
<b>70%-99%</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ Substantive organisation-wide compliance with all requirements set by the criterion</li> <li>◆ Demonstrable evidence that most parts of the organisation are meeting most of the requirements set by the criterion</li> <li>◆ Only minor non-compliance issues requiring, in the main minor action(s)</li> <li>◆ High percentage of compliance by professional people as part of the self-assessment process</li> </ul>
<b>100%</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ Full compliance across the organisation with all requirements set by the criterion</li> </ul>

Criterion No.	Description	Score (%)	Evidence	Comments
Standard 2	<p><b><i>Policy and Strategy</i></b>                      The organisation has documented policies and strategies for falls prevention and can demonstrate activity consistent with these policies.</p>			
Standard 4	<p><b><i>Appropriate Resource Allocation</i></b>                      The organisation provides appropriate human and physical resources to lead, implement and support falls prevention activities.</p>			
Standard 6	<p><b><i>Professional Development and Training</i></b>                      All employees, including managers and clinicians are provided, where appropriate, with adequate information, resources, training and professional development to support the organisation's falls prevention and harm minimisation activities.</p>			
Standard 7	<p><b><i>Measuring Effectiveness</i></b>                      The key performance indicator for a 5% reduction in the rate of inpatient falls as a percentage rate across the organisation is used to demonstrate the effectiveness of the organisation's falls prevention policy and strategy.</p>
